Program Impact:

- \$98,388 Extra Help Salaries and Wages: Polling Place Workers and Vote By Mail (VBM) processor reductions could mean longer wait at the polls and delays in processing returned VBM ballots.
- \$219,484 Postal Services: Voters choosing to Vote By Mail (VBM) have increased to over 50% of all registered voters (341,261). Each VBM voter is mailed their ballot resulting in higher postage costs.
- Sample Ballot Pamphlets are sent to each registered voter. The newly implemented Sample Ballot Opt Out program has received requests from a few hundred voters to date; the remaining 650,000 voters will be sent a Sample Ballot. At this time, the Ballot Opt Out program has not had a significant impact on postage costs.
